

One set of clothes per day + two more	In the summer, I choose t-shirts and shorts, but bring one or two jeans and sweatshirts with long arms for chilly nights	
Shoes and clothes for all weather	Sneakers, sandals, and waterproof boots. Rainwear, jacket.	
Tooth brush and toothpaste	Important, but can usually be bought at your location	
Medication	Everyday medication, fever meter and paracetamol just in case	
Wet Wipes	Nice to have for easy cleaning on the go and after meals	
Sunglasses and a sunhat	Protect them from the sun	
Bathing soap and shampoo	Campsites most of the time have showers for the guests to use. If you're going abroad and are staying at a hotel, you usually find this in your room (but not always)	
Sunlotion	Protection in the sun	
Snacks	For the car ride, or if you're flying. Snacks will keep them occupied for a little while, and it helps if they are hungry	
Tablet/iPad	If they are allowed one. Nice diversion if you're going to drive long distances or fly, or if it rains one day and you need a day in	
Toys	If you're flying it's fun with stickers, a drawing book, magnets or other small quiet toys. If you're driving, I really recommend getting them car bingo!
